Celebrating Black History Month

As we celebrate Black History Month, let's take a moment to recognize the valuable contributions of Black inventors who have significantly impacted the field of project management.

Throughout history, Black innovators have introduced groundbreaking inventions that have made project management more efficient and effective. For example, Mr. Garrett Morgan's 1923 patent for the traffic light inspired the concept of task prioritization and time management in project planning. Mr. Mark Dean holds three of nine PC patents for being the co-creator of the IBM personal computer released in 1981. In 1995, Mr. Dean was named the first ever African-American IBM Fellow. The co-invention of IBM's first computer paved the way for modern project management tools and software. Mr. Dean also worked on the development of the color monitor and led the team that developed the first gigahertz processor.

Dr. Marian R. Croak is a prolific inventor in the voice and data communication fields, with over 200 patents to her name. She is best known for developing Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP), technology that converts your voice into a digital signal, allowing you to make a call directly from a computer or other digital device. In 2022, Dr. Croak was inducted into the National Inventors Hall of Fame for her patent regarding VoIP technology. She is one of the first two Black women to receive that honor. Dr. Patricia Bath, an Ophthalmologist and inventor of the Laserphaco, a device and technique to remove cataracts was the second Black woman to receive the honor.

As we honor Black History Month, let us celebrate the achievements of Black inventors, and acknowledge the profound impact of their innovations on project management practices. To recognize and embrace diversity in innovation, we can continue to advance and evolve the field of project management for the betterment of all. What other notable Black inventors can you add to the list?
