Future City Engineering Fair

On October 22 PMI-DVC supported the <u>Future City Engineering Fair</u> by having a table in the exhibition hall where chapter president Bob Cochran talked to the students about project management and handed out chapter bling. Other chapter volunteers that made it happen were Eleanor Conwell, Suzanne, Dreitlein, Christina Heath, Dorian Perry, Audrey Wilson, and Ken Golkin VP of Education for PMI-DVC and as a member of the Philadelphia Future City Steering Committee managed the Engineering Fair. Over 50 students coming from ten different schools attended the event at SAP Headquarters in Newtown Square.

Talk To a PM

In previous Future City Engineering Fairs, the chapter provided a speaker to talk to the students about project management for the Future City Competition. During lessons learned discussions where there was general agreement that lecturing middle school students about project management induced more sleep and eyeball rolling than learning anything about project management. The volunteer team decided that we should take our message to the competing teams in their schools and provide coaching sessions that apply to each of the team's particular needs. The four volunteers: Christina Heath, Gary Rosenfeld, Mabel Samuel, and Suzanne Dreitlein divided up the seven schools and each scheduled a pre-meeting with the team's teacher to evaluate what area the students need the most project management help, then scheduled an hour meeting with the team. The participating schools are: Mount Aviat Academy in Childs, MD, E.N. Peirce Middle School in West Chester, PA, Queen of Angels RCS in Willow Grove, St. Martin de Porres CS in Philadelphia, PA, St. Mary Interparochial School in Philadelphia, PA, Sacred Heart School in Havertown, PA and J.R. Fugett Middle School in West Chester, PA.
