Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Team (DEI) Update

PMI-DVC June Guest Speakers - "Every Day DEI"

On June 15, 2022, the Chapter had the pleasure of hosting one of its own, Estelle Redding, and a guest, Dr. Marcine Pickron-Davis, to speak on the topic of Every Day DEI. Estelle is a member of our DEI Committee and the PMO Manager at Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, and Dr. Pickron-Davis serves as Chief Diversity and Community Relations Officer for Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine. They walked us through how we, as project leaders, can integrate simple DEI practices as part of our day-to-day project management.

Beyond defining key terms and walking through the history and evolution of DEI, both speakers shared enlightening stories and facts underpinned by three main objectives:

- 1. **Be accountable:** recognize that acceptance is not the same as agreement, and therefore not a compromise of beliefs. Choose to approach each other with respect and dignity.
- 2. **Be willing:** admit when our beliefs are wrong and be open to learning and changing based on new knowledge.
- 3. **Be proactive:** choose to take action in small, medium, and big ways when witnessing negativity as a result of biases.

If there's one takeaway from this presentation, it's that we can use the tools available to us to make a difference. As DEI practitioners, we believe that everyone has the ability to recognize and acknowledge privilege, understand different perspectives and incorporate inclusion as a behavior. Diversity, in its many forms, exists in the workplace and we can all actively support equity as a practice to provide individuals and groups with what they need to succeed. We want to thank both of our speakers, Estelle Redding and Dr. Marcine Pickron-Davis, for taking the time to help guide our members on the practical application of DEI as project managers and leaders within our organizations.


